

"Keeping Score" season spotlights Mahler

Two new episodes of "Keeping Score," Jewish conductor Michael Tilson Thomas's classical music television program, will debut June 23 ("Origins," premiere) and 30 ("Legacy"), respectively. The new season focuses on Gustav Mahler, famed Austrian-Bohemian Jewish composer, in the year of the 100th anniversary of his death.

Thomas, grandson of American Yiddish theatre movement founders Boris and Bessie Thomashefsky, aims to make classical music more accessible for all ages with his two-hour long documentary-style show.
