He befriends her new boyfriend Pablo, with the idea of eroding the couple – either by introducing Pablo to another woman or by seducing him himself. Thus emerges Plan B, a perilous romantic journey that calls Bruno's own sexuality into question.

"My Normal" is the story of Natalie, a young lesbian, who's struggling to find a balance between her dreams of becoming a filmmaker and her day job as the most desirable mistress in the NYC underground.
