



Craft Council Show scheduled for August in San Francisco

The American Craft Council Show in San Francisco will be held Aug. 13-15 at Fort Mason Center.

Debuting this year is the "Handmade Under \$100" category, showcasing artists who make work for sale for \$100 or less, and the "Lawn and Garden" category, highlighting artists who make furniture and decor for the outdoors.

Children can exercise creativity as well, at a MakeArt craft workshop on Saturday afternoon, sponsored by San Francisco Museum of Craft and Design.

The largest juried craft show in the West, the San Francisco [event](#) features 250 artists from the Bay Area and beyond.

The show runs from 10 a.m. to 8 p.m. Aug. 13, 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. Aug. 14 and 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Aug. 15.

Tickets are \$12 for one day or \$18 for two days, and \$5 after 5 p.m. Aug. 13 only. Children 12 and younger are admitted free.
