

California Bank & Trust Expands Nixon's Role to Include Northern California

Tory Nixon, who heads up the San Diego division for California Bank & Trust, was named to oversee the bank's Northern California division as well.

In his expanded role, Nixon will manage the San Diego based bank's business centers in San Francisco, the East Bay, Palo Alto, Fresno and Sacramento, along with 15 branches in the region, the bank said.

While heading the San Diego division in the last seven years, Nixon oversaw a 16 percent increase in both loans and deposit balances, said Chairman and CEO David Blackford.

California Bank & Trust is San Diego's largest headquartered bank with about \$11 billion in total assets.

Nixon made his mark in the National Football League before becoming a banker, and played on the 1988 Super Bowl Champion San Francisco Forty-Niners.
