Jack London Square lands a string of leases

Oakland's Jack London Square has landed more than 100,000 square feet of leases during 2011, including major expansions of solar company Sungevity and the arrival of a high-profile restaurant, Ellis Partners, the primary developer of the project, said Tuesday.

Besides the expansion of Sungevity, Jack London Square added Haven restaurant, which is led by famed chef Daniel Patterson.

In addition, the Live Culture Co., a local office of U.S. Sen. Barbara Boxer, a law firm and other organizations have recently signed leases in the project on Oakland's waterfront.
