



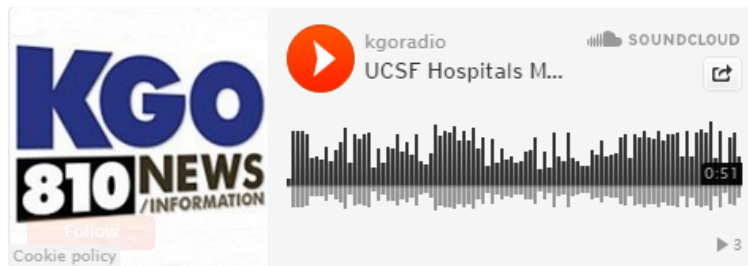
UCSF Hospitals Move to New Location

(KGO) - A team of hundreds of hospital workers completed the move from two UCSF hospitals to the new hospital facility on 16th Street in San Francisco yesterday. Working for eight and a half hours, workers used 41 ambulances to transport patients and equipment between hospitals.

Dr. Josh Adler, the Chief Medical Officer for the new hospital said, "it went from 7 am to 3:30 pm, actually 3:33 pm, 8.5 hours. And the number I was given was over 300 faculty, staff, and students."

He said that the new facility contains three medical facilities, the UCSF Benioff Children's Hospital, the UCSF Baker Cancer Hospital and the UCSF Betty Irene Moore Women's Hospital.
