A temporary hiring center will begin accepting applications Monday for Kerman's future Walmart Supercenter.

The hiring center, at 437 S. Madera Ave., will feature online kiosks that applicants can use to apply for jobs. The center will be open from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday

Walmart plans to hire 300 people to fill full- and part-time jobs for the new store at 14061 Whitesbridge Ave. Employees will begin work in July to prepare for the store's grand opening in late summer.
