The store, which is set to open this spring at 4080 Stevens Creek Boulevard in San Jose, isn't yet complete, so a hiring center has been set up in Sunnyvale.

Those interested in applying can head over to 1214 Apollo Way, Suite 404-1, between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday through Friday.

Most of those hired will begin work in April, to help prepare the store for its grand opening, according to Walmart representatives.
