## Walmart opening Neighborhood Market in Rocklin

A new Walmart Neighborhood Market store is set to open this week in Rocklin, which will see two stores under the retail giant's banner open in the next few months.

The Neighborhood Market store, at 5609 Pacific St., is about 53,000 square feet and is aimed at selling mostly grocery items in a convenient format, as well offering a few other products, and services such as a pharmacy and photo lab. After Wednesday's grand opening, which will include the announcement of \$8,000 in grants from Walmart and the Walmart Foundation to local charities, the store will be open 6 a.m. to midnight, seven days a week.

In addition to the grand opening, the city will have events Saturday afternoon to welcome the neighborhood. The store will have 95 employees.

This fall, Walmart is expected to have a slightly bigger store to show off, with the opening of a Walmart Supercenter in Rocklin at 5302 Crossings Drive. Such stores are usually three times the size of a Neighborhood Market store.

"The store will offer our Rocklin customers a one-stop shopping location for electronics, apparel, toys and home furnishings with the added convenience of a grocery store with fresh produce, bakery, meat and dairy products," said [Rachel Wall](#), Walmart's senior manager of communications, in an email statement.

When that store opens, Walmart will close its existing store at 1400 Lead Hill Boulevard in Roseville for renovations, and transfer employees to the Rocklin Supercenter. The Roseville store will undergo work to improve the store layout and energy and water efficiency, and is set to reopen in fall 2014. Hiring for that store is scheduled to start next summer.
