Walmart opening in Rocklin

After months of watching steady work building two shopping centers on either side of Interstate 80 in Rocklin at Sierra College Boulevard, passers-by will start seeing stores open, beginning Wednesday with the Walmart Supercenter anchoring one center.

This is an existing location elsewhere.

By the end of next year, Walmart will be joined by [PetSmart](#), [Panda Express](#) and [Great Clips](#) in Rocklin Crossings, at 5454 Crossings Drive. And in the same time frame and on the other side of the freeway, Rocklin Commons will see several stores open, including anchor store [Target](#), theater and dinner concept [Studio Movie Grill](#), [Stein Mart](#), [Ross](#) and [Panera Bread](#), according to [Donahue Schriber](#) Realty Group, which developed both centers.

According to Donahue Schriber's website, the first Rocklin Commons stores should open next spring, and currently has about 83,555 square feet of available space out of a total 359,000 square feet.

Rocklin Crossings, including the 191,000-square-foot Walmart Supercenter, has a total of 530,000 square feet. It has about 156,450 square feet of available space, according to the Donahue Schriber website, including both pad spaces and storefronts.

The Walmart Supercenter is a relocation from the site at 1400 Lead Hill Blvd. in Roseville. The relocation is adding about 85 jobs for a total of about 400 at the new store.
