

# Wal-Mart hiring 300 workers in Roseville

[Wal-Mart](#) Stores Inc. is hiring about 300 people for a Roseville store scheduled to open this fall.

The company has opened a hiring center at 106 North Sunrise Ave. Suite C3, in Roseville. The center is open 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. on weekdays and 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. on Saturdays. Full- and part-time jobs are available.

The jobs are for a Wal-Mart store at Lead Hill Boulevard near Rocky Ridge Drive in Roseville. A Wal-Mart store occupied the space since 2003, but that location [was overhauled](#) to create an upgraded store at the same site.

Upgrades at the store, which covers about 142,000 square feet, include a full-service grocery department.

The project has been underway for about a year. Many of the employees from the previous Roseville store moved to a Wal-Mart at the [new Rocklin Crossings shopping center](#).

People can also apply for jobs at the Roseville store with an [online application](#). Wal-Mart has a program that offers a job to any qualified veteran honorably discharged within the past 12 months.

Most employees at the Roseville Wal-Mart will begin work in September.
