

## Wal-Mart hiring almost 100 in Citrus Heights

Wal-Mart Stores Inc. is hiring almost 100 people for a Neighborhood Market that's opening in Citrus Heights.

The new Citrus Heights store fills 39,000 square feet. Wal-Mart Neighborhood Market stores are approximately one-third the size of a Wal-Mart Supercenter.

The smaller format stores include full grocery departments with organic and natural offerings. Shoppers also can expect prepared foods, a self-serve deli, bakery and more.
