



Wal-Mart hiring to fill Vacaville positions for new store

Walmart is now hiring to fill 95 full- and part-time positions at its Neighborhood Market on Alamo Drive in Vacaville, slated for a summer opening.

The majority of new associates will begin work in May, officials said.

The company's temporary hiring center is now open at 1015 Alamo Drive. Applications will be accepted Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Interested applicants should apply online at <http://careers.walmart.com> or visit the hiring center during business hours.

Walmart provides a benefits program to eligible full- and part-time associates.

For example, it provides a variety of affordable health and well-being benefits including health-care coverage with no lifetime maximum. The average wage for full-time hourly associates in California is \$12.93. Walmart also offers eligible associates matching 401(k) contributions of up to 6 percent of pay, discounts on general merchandise, an Associate Stock Purchase Program and company-paid life insurance. Additionally, eligible associates receive a quarterly incentive based on store performance.

Beginning Memorial Day, Walmart will offer a job to any honorably discharged veteran within his or her first 12 months off active duty. The company projects that it will hire more than 100,000 veterans over the next five years.
