

Free redwood parks passes available second Saturdays this year

A limited number of free passes to one of 40 California redwood state parks are being offered on the second Saturday of every month this year, and online registrations are being taken now for Feb. 10.

The Save the Redwoods League is celebrating its centennial this year, and with the assistance of Oracle is making 16,800 day use parking passes available throughout the year.

There are a limited number of passes for each park, and all of them have been claimed for some of the destinations. Those that still have opening can be picked at FreeRedwoodsDays.org.

Fill out the registration form there and an email will be sent immediately with a link to a downloadable pass.

You must print out the pass to use it. Displaying it on a smartphone or tablet won't work as the pass either has to be given to a gate attendant or placed on the car dash in unstaffed parks.

You can only sign up for one park, and the pass is good for everyone in a vehicle.

March 10 passes will be available for download starting at 8 a.m. on Feb. 26.
