



## Free passes available for state parks

Save the Redwoods League and California State Parks have collaborated for the third consecutive year, and are now offering free day-use admission to more than 40 redwood state parks on Nov. 24, the day after Thanksgiving.

More than 2,500 free vehicle day-use passes will be available for participating redwood state parks. The passes cover day-use admission and parking fees. Passes are limited and available on a first-come, first-served basis at [RedwoodsFriday.org](http://RedwoodsFriday.org). Some of the parks include Del Norte Coast Redwoods State Park, Humboldt Redwoods State Park, Jedediah Smith Redwoods State Park, Patrick's Point State Park, Prairie Creek Redwoods State Park, Richardson Grove State Park, Standish-Hickey State Recreation Area and more.
