**Veterinary Technology Students at Carrington College Pomona
Practice Hands-On Horse Training at Hart Ranch**

WHO: Veterinary Technology students at the [Carrington College Pomona campus](#) practice veterinary techniques on horses in a real-world setting at [Hart Ranch](#) in Corona.

WHAT: During the hands-on lab, students will demonstrate their ability to take vital signs on a horse, including temperature, pulse and respiratory rate. Students will also apply limb bandages, obtain blood samples and perform radiographs (X-rays) on the horses.

According to the [U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics](#), employment of veterinary technologists and technicians is expected to grow by 30 percent between 2012 and 2022.

Veterinary Technology faculty at the Carrington College Pomona campus provide students with the knowledge, training and practical experience needed to help them succeed in this growing and competitive profession. Carrington students who complete the 88-week program go on to receive an associate of science degree in Veterinary Technology.

Hart Ranch in Corona is well known for breeding horses – many have been used in Hollywood movies, participated popular polo matches, served as rope and show horse, and one even appeared in the U.S. Olympics.
