KBIS Taps Top Trends

For design pros interested in learning about what's up next when it comes to kitchen and bath products, the Kitchen & Bath Industry Show held in January did not disappoint. Celebrating its fourth year as part of Design and Construction Week, KBIS 2017 showcased a range of cutting-edge products across the halls of the Orange County Convention Center in Orlando, FL.

Among the standout trends displayed on this year's exhibit floor were cabinets in muted tones such as gray and taupe, marble-look and gray-toned countertops, kitchen sinks as prep and entertainment centers, reclaimed wood-look counters and vanities, and clever internal storage that makes use of every inch of space. Black was everywhere – from matte black on faucets to black stainless on appliances. But the star this year was connectivity, with smart appliances, showers, alarm systems and water heaters leading the pack.
