

Your guide to food, shops planned at Delta Shores (Slideshow)

Last week, Wal-Mart Stores Inc. broke ground on a 186,000-square-foot Supercenter in the planned Delta Shores shopping center, marking the latest step in a project that's expected to include a large assortment of stores and eateries.

A website for the project in South Sacramento lists at least 40 businesses planned for the retail center. The newest additions include Amazing Lash Studio and Smoosh, a locally owned ice cream sandwich business that's rapidly expanding.

Covering just under 100 acres near the new Delta Shores Parkway interchange with Interstate 5, the retail center will be the first phase of the Delta Shores project. Merlone Geier Partners is the master developer for the project, which will cover 800 acres and have up to 5,200 homes.

The first stores could open in fall 2017.
