



Children's hospital completes 10-year renovation project

The decade-long renovation and expansion of Lucile Packard Children's Hospital Stanford (Calif.) has been completed and patients have been moved into in the new facility, according to an article on the [Fierce Healthcare](#) website.

The redesign aimed to create a facility with patients — and caregivers — in mind. The hospital has gardens for patients and families alongside balconies and quiet spaces for clinical workers.
