

Federated Indians of Graton Rancheria donate \$50,000 to REFB

On Tuesday, December 7, 2021, Federated Indians of Graton Rancheria donated \$50,000 to the Redwood Empire Food Bank. The Graton Rancheria community is a federation of Coast Miwok and Southern Pomo groups collectively recognized as a tribe by the U.S. Congress in 1990.



Tribal Council Chairman Greg Sarris explains, "The Tribe knows that people need food, and we are proud to support the Redwood Empire Food Bank. It is in line with our mission of social justice and environmental stewardship. It is important and the right thing to do to contribute to our community."

David Goodman, CEO of REFB says, "The Federated Indians of Graton Rancheria have been generous to us from the beginning. By providing \$50,000, this will equate to about \$200,000 worth of food, thanks to our volunteers who were also inspired to donate. In light of recent disasters, there are a lot of people in need and the Redwood Empire Food Bank is here to respond."
