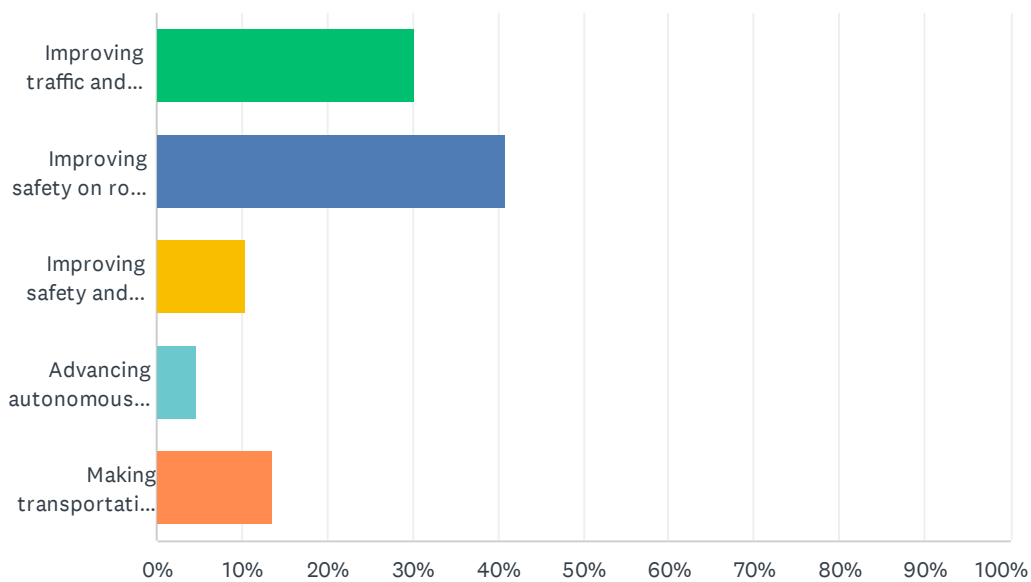


Safer Mobility Survey

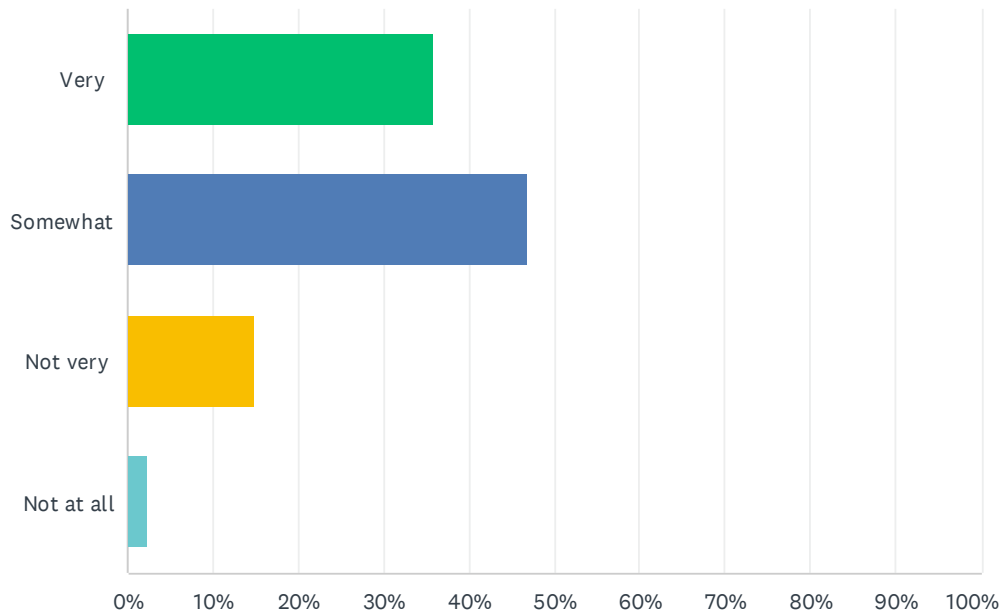
PAVE and AEye conducted a survey of 1095 adults in November 2022 to gauge their views on road safety for all road users, including drivers, pedestrians and bicyclists.

What transportation issue is most important to you?



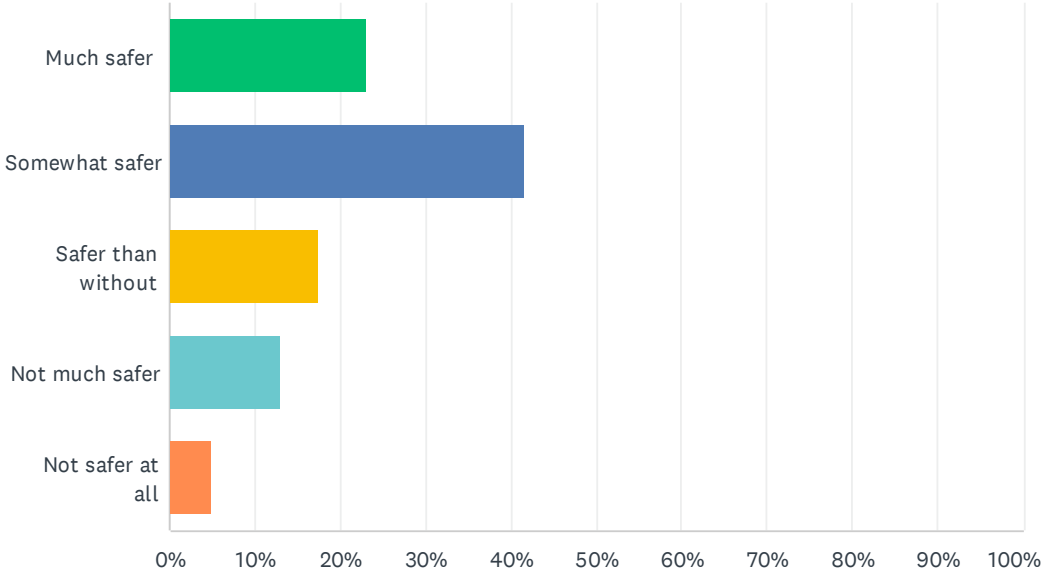

As a driver, how concerned are you about getting in a collision?



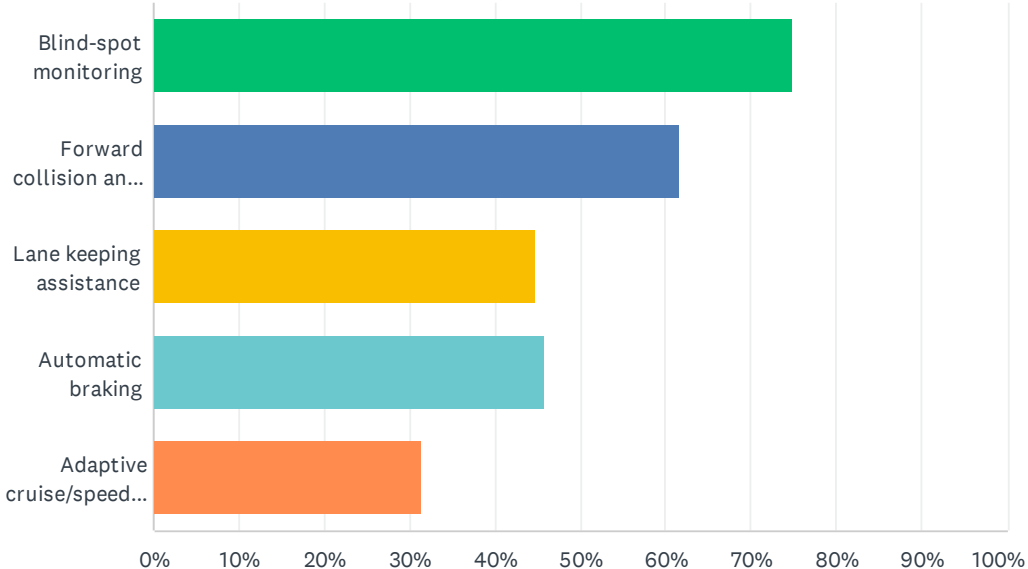

How much safer do you feel having vehicles with ADAS (advanced driver assistance systems) features, such as autonomous braking, blind spot monitoring and lane assist?



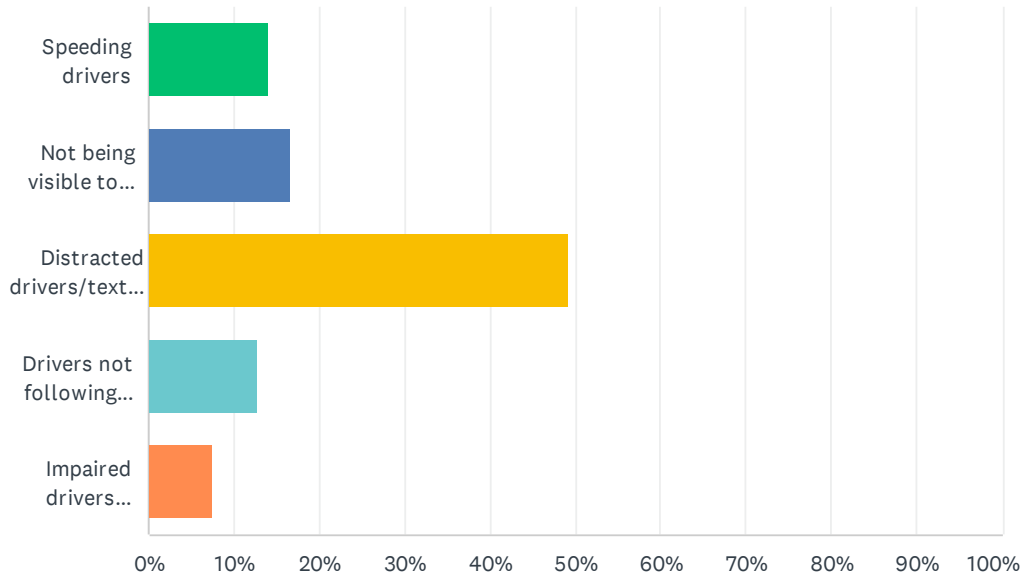

Which advanced driver assistance technology features are most important to you? Choose all that apply.



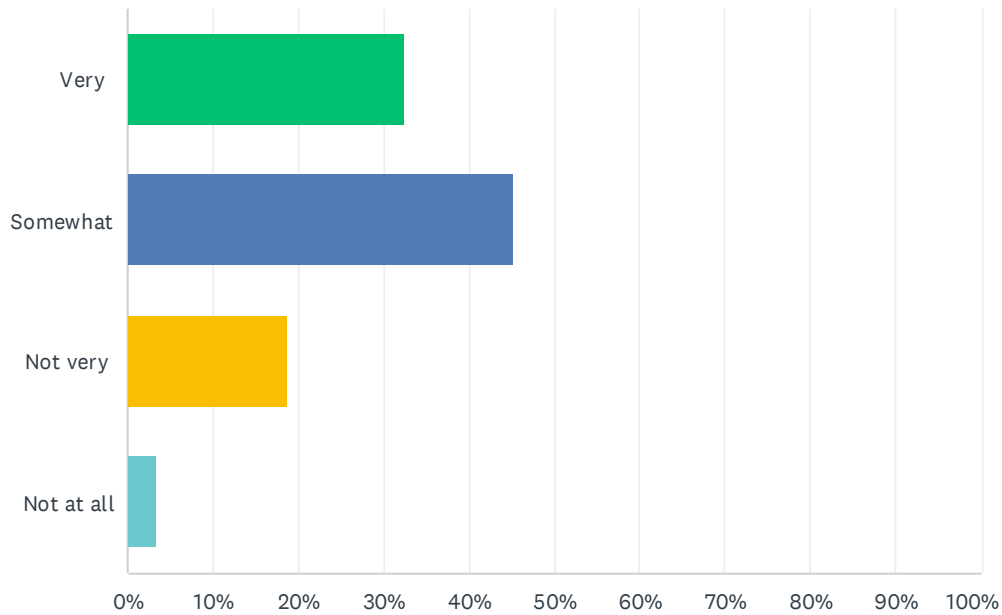

From the perspective of a pedestrian or bicyclist, what do you believe is the number one road safety issue?



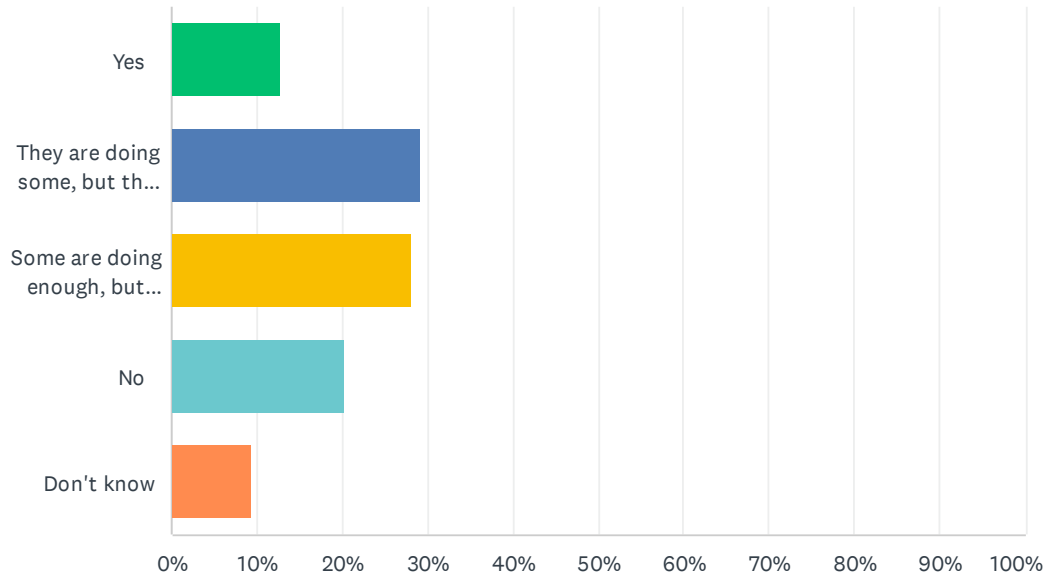

As a pedestrian or bicyclist, how concerned are you about being struck by a vehicle?



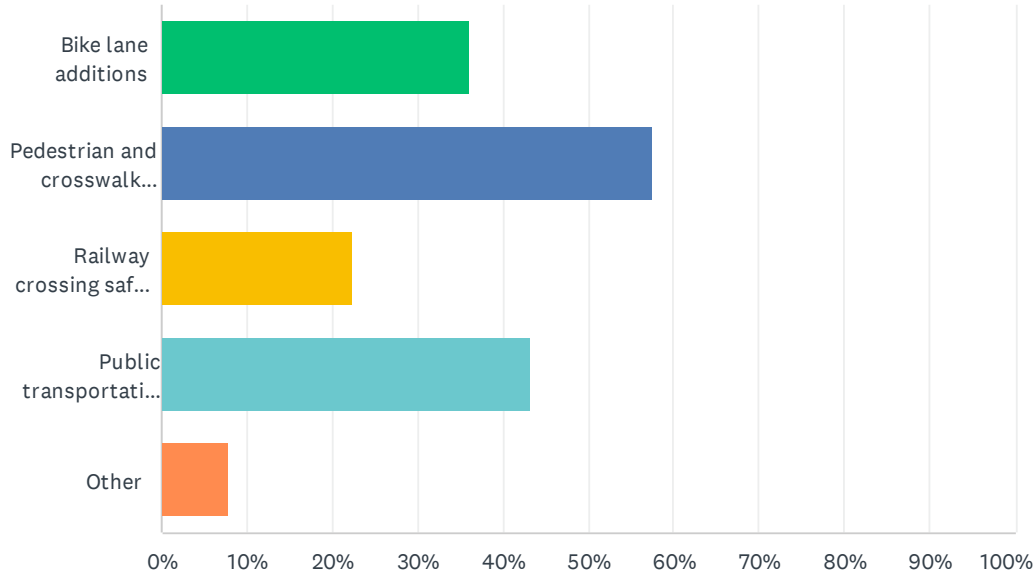

Are cities and towns doing enough to address pedestrian/bicyclist safety?



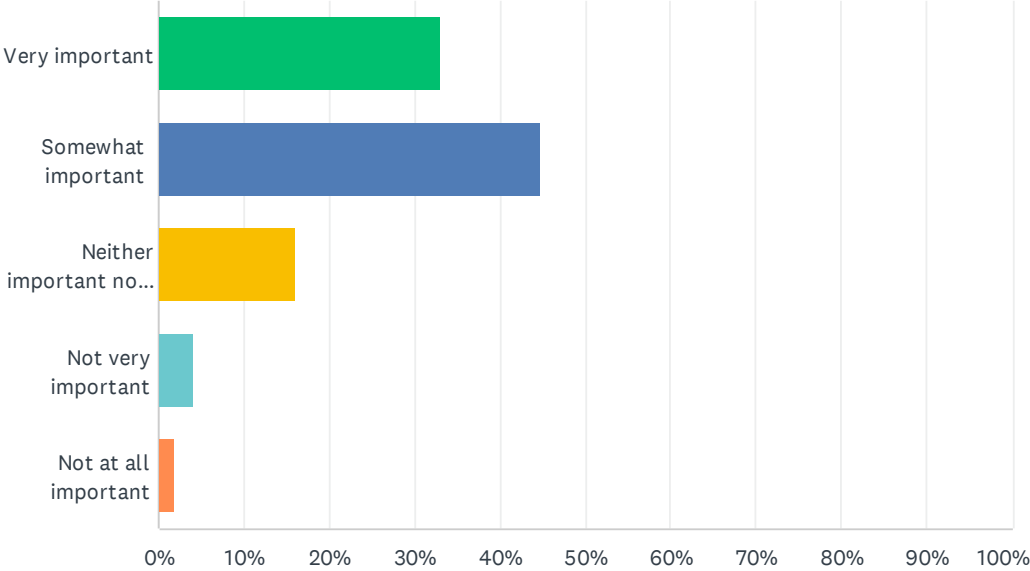

Which of the following non-automotive transportation issues would you like to see addressed in your city or town? Choose all that apply.



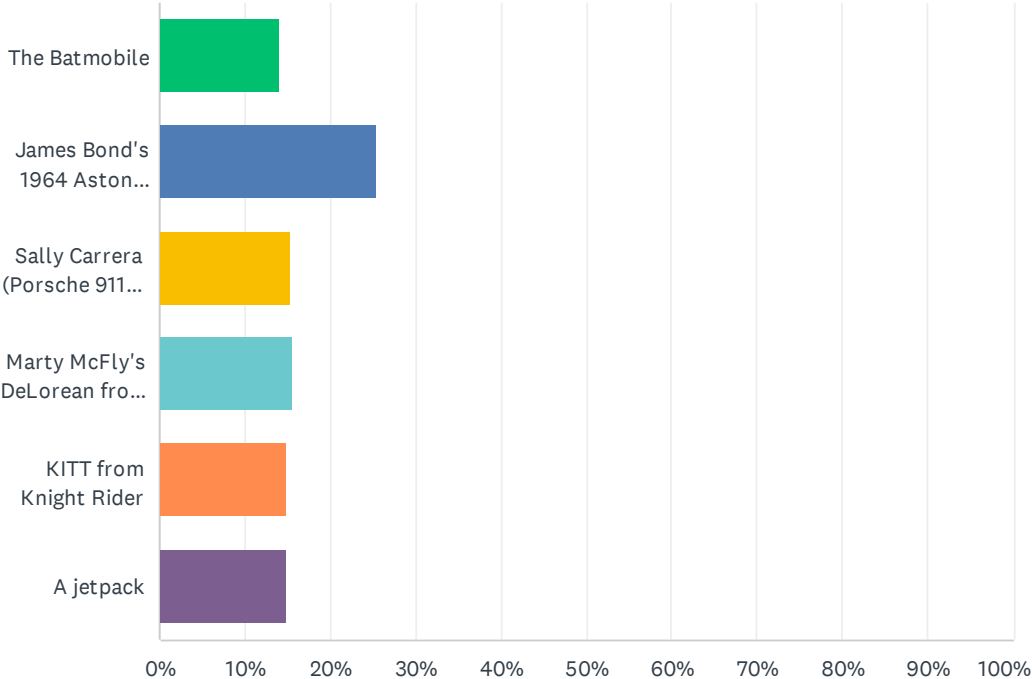

How important do you think technology is in solving driving safety issues?



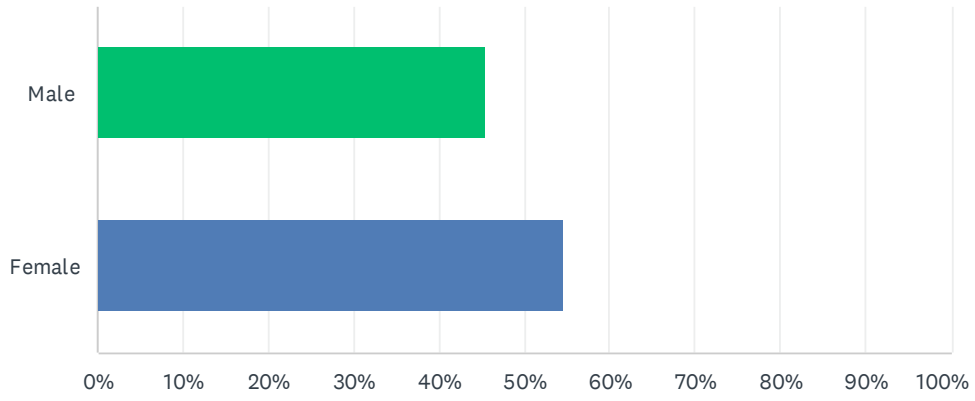

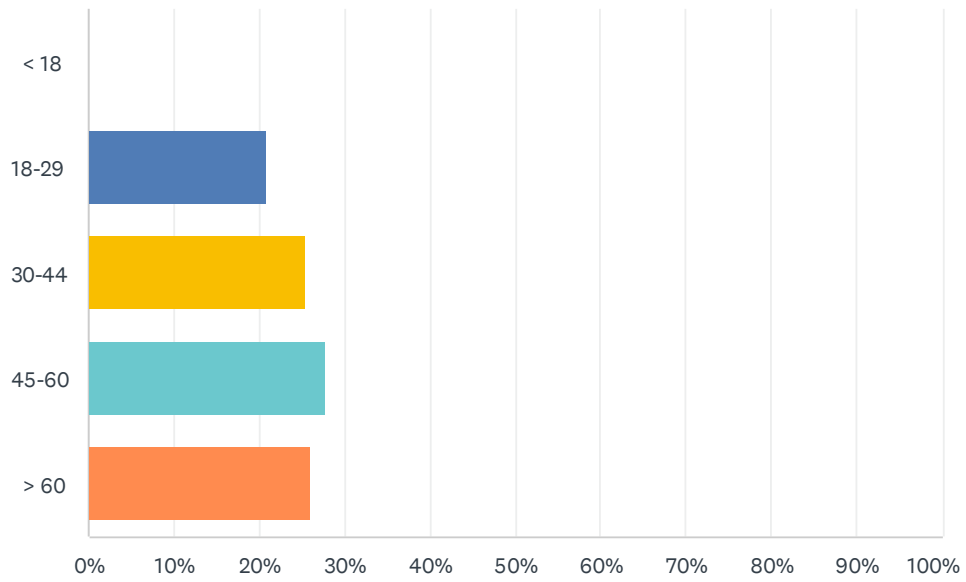
